TOOTSIE ROLL FUNDRAISER A SUCCESS

Thanks to all of you Knights that helped with the Tootsie Roll Fundraiser for Developmentally Disadvantaged persons. As usual, at least for the last two years, a couple of days were not the best weather-wise, but we still did all right.

Total amount collected was \$1,885.56, which was about \$12 more than last year. We collected \$520.19 after the masses at St. Francis and \$1,365.37 at Silver Lake over three days. The average per two hour period was \$113.78. So you can see that it paid to be out there, and that despite the economic times, people were generous. People know just what we are asking for when they see our aprons!

Money raised for this is sent to the State Council, who gives 100% of it to the organization our council chooses. We usually designate it two local organizations that focus on developmentally disadvantaged children. Decision will be made at the May Council Meeting.


